Work in pairs. Memorize these lines from “Romeo and Juliet” and act them out in class in your next lesson. They are from the famous ‘balcony scene’ (Act 2, scene 2). This is what happens:

After the party where Romeo and Juliet meet and fall in love, Romeo leaves the house of the Capulets and wanders into a small street behind the house garden. He wants to be with Juliet, so he decides to jump over the wall into the garden hoping to see her. He hides among the trees until Juliet appears on the balcony and Romeo sees her. This is what they say:

ROMEO AND JULIET: the balcony scene

ROMEO: But wait, what's that light in the window over there? It is the east, and Juliet is the sun. Rise up, beautiful sun, and kill the jealous moon. The moon is already sick and pale with grief because you, Juliet, her maid, are more beautiful than she.

JULIET: Oh, my!

ROMEO: (to himself) She speaks. Oh, speak again, bright angel. You are as glorious as an angel tonight. You shine above me, like a winged messenger from heaven who makes mortal men fall on their backs to look up at the sky, watching the angel walking on the clouds and sailing on the air.

JULIET: (not knowing ROMEO hears her) Oh, Romeo, Romeo, why do you have to be Romeo? Forget about your father and change your name. Or else, if you won't change your name, just swear you love me and I'll stop being a Capulet.

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
